A NIH funded Postdoctoral Research position in Blood Brain Barrier (BBB) Biology / microbiology is available in the Department MMI, Johns Hopkins SPH in Baltimore, MD, USA. We are using multidisciplinary approaches to study mechanisms of activation of blood brain barrier (BBB) endothelium, including in-vitro cell culture models exposure to pathogens (Plasmodium infected erythrocytes) and studies of signaling systems in cerebral malaria. The long term goal is to develop novel therapeutics and discover novel disease biomarkers. This project also involves collaborations with the Department of Neurology, SOM. Opportunities may exist to attend scientific and/or working meetings. This project also involves various USA-national and international collaborations.
